The Ditchpro® is a more effective and efficient way to clean roadside ditches. Ditchpro® is designed to fit any class 50 or larger wheel loader and installs in seconds to a quick coupler equipped wheel loader.

The 1 cubic yard bucket extends up to 4 feet to allow the Wheel loader to remain on the road surface. The opening in the top of the bucket allows the operator to view the material filling the bucket while moving the wheel loader slowly forward with the Ditchpro attached.

- Pays for itself each time you use it, by cleaning 5 to 10 times the length of ditch that can be cleaned daily with a conventional ditching bucket attached to the front of a wheel loader.



The Ditchpro Bucket can be extended to allow the removing of debris with the wheel loader remaining on the road surface

- Reduces damage and wear to road edges and wheel loader, compared to conventional ditching bucket attached to the front of a wheel loader.



When the bucket is filled with debris (operator can see the bucket filling from the cab by watching viewing hole in the top of the bucket). The Ditchpro can then be lifted and dumped

After dumping the debris, you can return to the ditch and repeat the process.
